15 Ways to Use Fine Arts beyond the Festival

Suggested list to help students discover and develop their ministry gifts.

1. Put on a dinner theatre—Connects the church and youth, raises money and give students a chance to make their presentations. Alternate singing, drama and video.
2. Sunday mornings—Use as part of a message, offertory or youth Sunday.
3. Outreach night in your youth ministry—Have students invite their friends to come and watch them.
4. Have school drama/vocal teacher work with students.
5. Fine Arts Fair—Invite students from community to grow in the arts. Invite local individuals to teach and critique students.
6. Display student's art work/photos in youth room.
7. Invite school band/choir to your Sunday service to sing. Afterward have a pizza party as a way of building relationships.
8. Sectional Rallies—Students minister with singing, dancing, and drama at their youth rallies.
9. After school programs—Have students use their gifts in after-school programs or Sunday School.
10. Older students/leaders work with younger students in the arts as they disciple them.
11. Invite student's parents for a service where youth are making their presentations.
12. Illustrated sermon—have students act out the passage you are reading from as part of the message.
13. Record a worship/Christian band CD to give/sell to your church. (Make sure you secure all copyright info prior to making the CD.)
14. Put together a Fine Arts Tour. Travel to several churches with your choir, drama, and band.
15. Have a Fine Arts Retreat. Spend the weekend practicing and talking about the heart of the artist.

ACSI FINE ARTS FESTIVAL 2012



Purpose of the Festival

The ACSI Fine Arts Festival is held to provide Christian schools and their students with an opportunity to honor the Lord through demonstrated artistic talents. It is recognized that the students who participate in this event desire to glorify God

Description

The Fine Arts Festival has two components: Arts and Music. Schools should conduct their school-wide selection and send their top two participants to the festival. Please visit www.acsiphils.org for the Fine Arts Festival Handbooks.

School-wide Selection

The school must conduct a school-wide selection process on or before November 2011 to select their entries for the festival.

Eligibility

Any member school of ACSI Philippines may participate in the ACSI Fine Arts Festival. Grade 5, grade 6 and high school students are eligible to participate.

Adult Helpers

Each school is required to provide one adult helper for every 10 students attending the festival. The adult helper must be available for the entire day, though each helper will work either morning or in the afternoon. A music director or art instructor should not serve as an adult helper throughout the day because of other responsibilities. Schools will be charged Php 1,800.00 penalty fee for each adult helper they fail to provide.



Visual Arts

The categories of visual arts component are:

- Painting
 - Acrylic
 - Tempera
 - Oil
 - Watercolor
- Drawing
 - Charcoal
 - Crayon
 - Pencil
 - Colored Pencil
 - Pen and Ink
- Photography
 - Black and White
 - Digital
 - Color
 - Montage

A school may enter a maximum of 2 entries per category, not exceeding a total of 15 visual arts entries. Not more than two visual arts entries per student will be accepted.

Adjudication & Awards

Performance shall be rated by the adjudicators against a standard performance scale. Ribbons will be given to individuals and small ensembles who merit the award.

Individuals or small groups that have achieved Excellent or Superior highest rating shall receive a medallion or a certificate in that category.

Recognition

Each student will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Student will receive a ribbon awarded on the bases of the work being judged.

Superior—Blue Ribbon
Excellent—Red Ribbon
Good—White Ribbon

Insurance

All schools participating in an event with the ACSI are required to have adequate insurance coverage for students and advisors/teachers. ACSI does not assume responsibility for this coverage.

The school's student accident insurance should cover most reasonable and customary medical expenses. Workman's Compensation should cover advisors/teachers.

Workshops

Workshops are available for students and advisor/teachers to attend during the day of the festival. This is to be facilitated by experts in the following fields:

- * Painting
- * Drawing
- * Photography Essentials
- * Exploring Computer Graphics
- * Theatre
- * Voice & Diction
- * Ethnic Dance
- * Interpretative Dancing

Seats are limited per workshop. Schedule and tickets will be available at the festival in the registration area. Pre-registration is NOT available for these workshops. There is a Php 100.00 charge per student to attend these workshops but students with entries are not charged.

CATEGORIES

Music

The categories of music component include the following:

Classical/Sacred/Traditional category

- Voice (Solo & Group of 4+ Members)
- Piano Solo
- Bowed Strings (Violin Solo or Ensemble (String Quartet/Ensemble))
- Plucked Strings (Classical Guitar Solo)
- Wind Instrument (Flute & Clarinet Solo)
- Brass Instrument (Bb Trumpet Solo)
- Symphonic Band

Contemporary Christian Music/Gospel category

- Voice (Solo & Group of 4+ Members)
- Band (3-8 members)



A student may participate in a maximum of four entries. One person may accompany up to four performances. However, a student who is performing and accompanying may not exceed a total of five events, and a director who is accompanying and directing performances may not exceed a total of six events. This will help to avoid scheduling conflicts.
